## **WorkSafeBC COVID Safe Plan**

### **Step 1: Risk assessment**

I work from home in my office most of the time. The only time that I work outside my home are when I visit a construction site to inspect construction that I have designed.

No one visits me in my home office. My wife and I are practicing self isolation per the BC PHO recommendations. There are no risks in my home office that are greater than the risks in my home.

There are no known cases of COVID on Quadra Island. I do not do work on construction site that are not on Quadra Island. This limits my risks significantly.

### **Step 2: Protocols to reduce risk**

I have not implemented any changes at home to reduce the risks because the risks are not there.

When I visit a construction site, I practice social distancing. I wear a mask and gloves where social distancing is not possible.

### **Step 3: Policies**

I follow the safety policies of the general contractor on each construction site.

### **Step 4: Communication plan**

There is no need for a communication plan since I am the only person involved.

### **Step 5: Monitor and update plan**

Should the PHO rules change or there are known COVID cases on Quadra Island, this plan will be updated.

### **Step 6: Resuming operations**

Business never stopped so there is no need to plan for resuming operation.
